

Venture further beyond the city to explore carefully preserved 18th century castles and forts that reveal the secrets of traditional life in Qatar.




Qatar Philharmonic Orchestra

Licenses (Entertainment and Exhibition Costs)

As per Government regulations in Qatar, dedicated licenses from the concerned Ministries are required if the following items are involved in the event:

- 1. Exhibition/Conference License: Should an event involve an Exhibition that incorporates stands/ shell schemes/ tables used as stands for the purpose of product display, promotion or sponsors, an Exhibition License is required to be procured from the Qatar National Tourism Council. The Costs of the License ranges from approximately (QAR 500/ USD 137 to QAR 10,000/ USD 2,747) depending on the type of the event.
- 2. Entertainment License: Should the event involve any kind of entertainment (dance/ music etc.), an entertainment license from the Ministry of Culture is required to be obtained prior to the event. Please note as per governmental regulations no religious decoration or singing is allowed. The Cost of this license is approximately QAR 5000/USD 1,374

It should be noted here that the above-mentioned licenses can only be obtained by a local events management company. Any international organizer must employ the services of the local company who may render a service fee in order to procure the license.
